

Can I open the battery cabinet after the UPS is turned off



Overview

Do not dismantle, crush, puncture, open or shred the Li-ion battery. Before removing or reconnecting with the running system, the power must be off and the system should be shut down, otherwise there will be risk of electric shock. Use insulated tools suitable for working on batteries. The battery cabinet contains an internal energy source. Hazardous voltage is still present after the battery. Is it ok to turn off my UPS when not in use?

APC by Schneider Electric notes that this question is often asked by our customers who would want to make sure there are no electronics that are on while they leave their homes or their place of work/business. It can also apply to times of expected power. I switch off the button of the UPS unit DEXP EURO after turning off the computer.

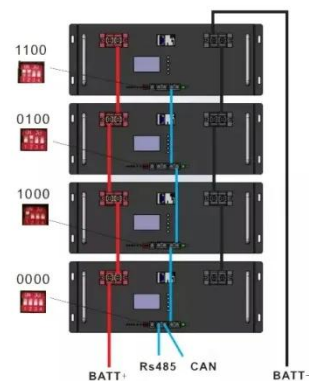
Proper Use of UPS Units

If your computer is turned off, the UPS is doing nothing and you can safely turn it off. As long as the UPS is plugged into an electric source, it will continue to keep the internal battery charged.
