

# High altitude wind parachute power generation control system



## Overview

---

The parachute—also known as a power-generating kite—is a core device for harnessing wind at altitudes exceeding 300 meters. It converts wind energy into electricity by driving ground-based generators through a traction cable. At altitudes of up to 750 meter, these extremely robust kites spin in “figures of eight” loops while connected to a ground station via a cable winch. The resulting traction force is converted into clean energy by a generator on the ground. Moving constantly higher and lower, almost like a yo-yo. China successfully conducted the deployment and retrieval tests for a 5,000-square-meter high-altitude wind energy capture parachute at a test site in Alxa Left Banner, Inner Mongolia, on November 12. In this work, we proposed an airborne wind energy system (AWES) based on parachutes, which utilizes a cascade of parachutes exploiting. Aerodynamic force for parachute has two components: tangential force  $T$  (along the axe) and normal force  $N$ . Both  $T$  and  $N$  are proportional to the surface area of the canopy, and the air dynamic pressure  $q$ :  $= C (\alpha)$  But if  $\alpha \leq 25^\circ$ , the equilibrium state is stable.

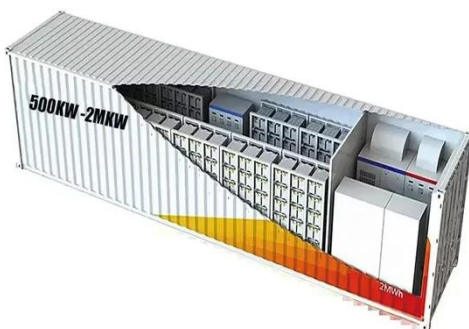

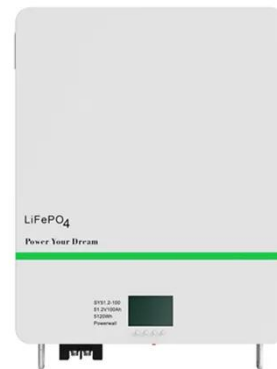

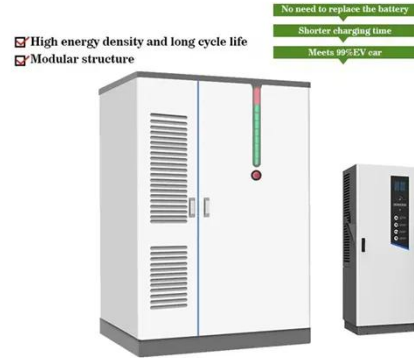
