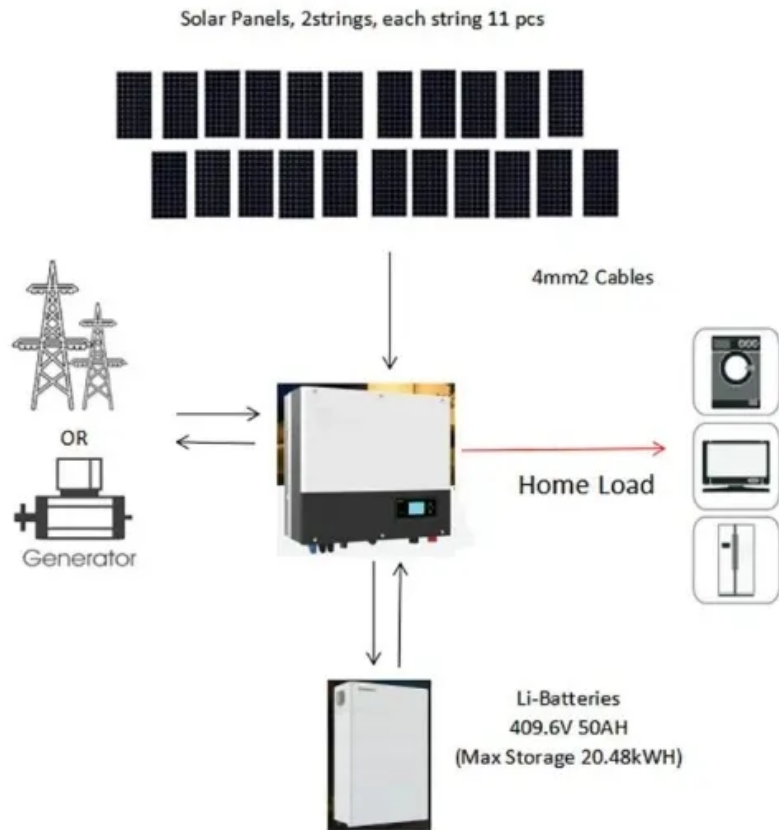


Outdoor power outage in Eastern Europe



Overview

Countries reportedly affected include Germany, Poland, Austria, Italy, and Hungary, with varying degrees of disruption. In some cities, street lights went out and public transport systems halted. Airports and hospitals switched to emergency generators. Millions of homes faced. It was an ordinary Monday morning — until entire cities went dark without warning. What started as isolated reports quickly turned into a continent-wide scramble as parts of Europe were plunged into a sudden blackout. So, where exactly did the power fail?

Spain bore the brunt of the outage, with. Spain, Portugal and parts of south-west France were all hit by a mass blackout on Monday, shutting down flights, trains, traffic lights and offices.
