

Palau energy conservation



Overview

Several opportunities exist for reducing energy consumption in Palau from fossil fuels, mostly as energy efficiency upgrades or purchasing incentives, although renewable energy opportunities also exist. The International Renewable Energy Agency (IRENA) is an intergovernmental organisation that supports countries in their transition to a sustainable energy future and serves as the principal platform for international co-operation, a centre of excellence, and a repository of policy, technology. It provides actions for reducing the Republic's energy consumption, both in the public and private sector. As part of the REP-5 programme funding for Palau, an Energy Planner has also been hired to implement the actions contained within the EEAP. Palau's residential electricity rates are approximately \$0. dollars (USD) per kilowatt-hour (kWh), more than twice the average U. residential. Palau is the westernmost Micronesian country, 800 km east of the southern Philippines. Eighty percent of its approximately 21,000 inhabitants live in or around the largest urban center, Koror. 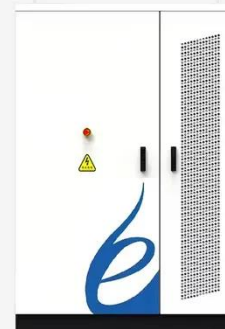
