

Vatican city electric vehicle policy

The "Ecological Conversion 2035" program, launched in 2022 and aimed at reducing CO2 emissions to zero, has accomplished another important goal: Starting June 16, charging stations for electric vehicles owned by the State and private ones belonging to employees of the Governorate and the Holy See. The Governorate of Vatican City State announces the launch of a series of energy-saving initiatives and strategies to safeguard the environment in the framework of the Pope's Laudato si' and Laudate Deum, including introducing a state car fleet to reduce CO2 emissions through a partnership with the. Fourteen electric vehicles – four passenger Melex intended for the Gendarmerie and ten utility Goupil for the needs of Vatican City State – have been provided by Exelentia (Italian Mobility Factory), enabling the Governorate to continue the implementation of its sustainable mobility development. By partnering with Volkswagen, the Vatican aims to have only electric vehicles by 2030 so as to have a carbon neutral fleet. 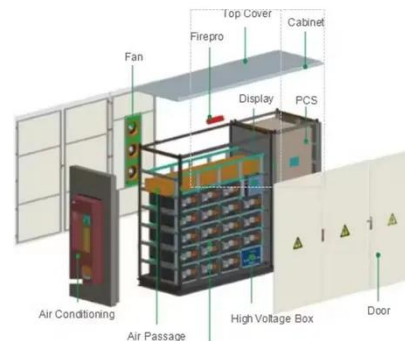
